1. Acceptance of These Terms

These Terms govern your use of VibeCheck. By creating an account, logging in, uploading a document, using the service, or purchasing a subscription, you agree to these Terms and the VibeCheck Privacy Policy.

2. Eligibility

VibeCheck is intended for users aged 18 or older. VibeCheck is initially designed for freelancers and professional users. Business/agency use may be introduced later under additional terms.

3. What VibeCheck Provides

VibeCheck provides software that can help users review contractual language, identify areas that may deserve attention, understand observations and contextual information, provide supported legal, regulatory, and cross-border context, and prepare user-controlled negotiation material.

4. No Legal, Tax or Professional Advice

VibeCheck outputs are informational and decision-support outputs. They are not legal advice, legal opinions, tax advice, accounting advice, certification, compliance certification, enforceability determination, fairness determination, or a safe-to-sign determination.

An empty finding list does not mean no legal issue exists. 'Needs Attention' does not by itself establish legal non-compliance. A numeric score is an attention or negotiation signal, not a legal-compliance score.

5. Accounts and Authentication

The service supports passwordless email Magic Link authentication and Google Sign-In. Google Sign-In uses the openid, email, and profile scopes solely for authentication and account creation.

You are responsible for controlling the email account or supported third-party account used to access VibeCheck. Google account processing is described in the Privacy Policy.

6. Information You Provide

You are responsible for providing accurate information where VibeCheck needs it to provide the service. Profile fields are declared work context, not identity verification or legal-status determination.

7. Uploading Documents

You may upload documents only when you have the right and authority to do so. You are responsible for client confidentiality, intellectual-property rights, contractual restrictions, and third-party privacy rights.

Do not intentionally upload passwords, API keys, payment-card credentials, authentication codes, or other secrets unrelated to the contract-review purpose.

8. Ownership of Your Content

You retain your rights in contracts and other content you submit. Mehta Industries does not acquire ownership of uploaded contracts merely because you use VibeCheck.

You grant VibeCheck a limited, non-exclusive right to host, copy, process, transform, display, and otherwise use submitted content only as reasonably necessary to provide, secure, maintain, and support the services you request, subject to the Privacy Policy and applicable law.

9. Confidentiality and Third-Party Information

If a contract contains information belonging to a client, employer, counterparty, or other third party, you are responsible for ensuring you are authorized to submit and process it through VibeCheck.

10. Document Processing and PII Redaction

The intended pipeline includes server-side extraction and PII redaction before eligible contract-derived text is sent to the AI provider. The redaction layer targets supported identifiers but cannot guarantee detection of every sensitive value.

11. AI-Assisted Features

VibeCheck uses Anthropic Claude Sonnet 4.6 for eligible AI-assisted analysis. AI processes only eligible server-side redacted contract-derived text; raw uploaded document bytes are not sent to Claude. AI may assist with finding identification, interpretation, explanations, confidence/uncertainty, suggested actions, reform wording, alternatives, and response drafts.

AI is not authorized to make final legal decisions, certify compliance, declare a contract safe to sign, approve reform wording, select negotiation material, modify the original contract, or invent legal sources.

12. Legal Knowledge and Deterministic Results

VibeCheck may provide India-first legal, regulatory, and cross-border context within its supported knowledge and deterministic rules. VibeCheck does not provide GST calculations, TDS calculations, invoice drafting, or a universal determination of tax liability. Where facts, rules, source coverage, or jurisdictional information are unavailable or conflicting, the system may return uncertainty or an unsupported state.

13. Findings and Risk / Attention Score

Findings are observations or advisory interpretations. Attention levels are presentation and reading-order signals, not legal verdicts. A numeric score, where shown, measures product attention/negotiation significance and not legal compliance, enforceability, legality, or safety.

14. Reform Features

A Reform draft may be created from a finding. The user may edit proposed wording and explicitly approve it before selection for a counter-proposal. The original contract is not changed by the Reform workflow.

15. Counter-Proposals and Generated Artifacts

Counter-Proposal artifacts are assembled from human-selected, user-approved reform wording and stored separately from the original contract.

VibeCheck does not automatically amend the original contract and does not autonomously send a counter-proposal to another party.

Generated documents are negotiation material, not executed agreements or legal opinions.

16. Free and Paid Plans

Current India pricing: Free - INR 0 and 2 lifetime analyses; Starter - INR 299 per month and 5 analyses per month; Pro - INR 999 per month and 15 analyses per month.

The current launch has no trial and no launch-time add-on purchase UI. Future add-on catalog entries do not create a purchase right until the purchase flow is enabled and priced.

17. Analysis Credits

Free credits are lifetime-based. Starter and Pro included credits are monthly. Unused monthly included credits do not roll over under the current commercial policy.

Where an analysis fails and a reserved credit is safely released, the credit may be restored. Integrity failures may require server-side reconciliation before another attempt.

18. Subscription Activation

Opening or completing checkout does not itself activate a paid plan. Paid access becomes effective after the relevant payment confirmation and server-side billing update are processed. Razorpay is the current payment provider.

19. Subscription Status and Cancellation

Subscriptions may be active, incomplete, past due, canceled, or expired. Users may cancel recurring subscriptions through the available VibeCheck/payment-provider flow. Cancellation stops future renewal while the user retains paid access through the end of the applicable current billing period, subject to provider configuration and applicable law. VibeCheck relies on server-side billing state and provider webhooks to finalize cancellation and entitlement status.

20. Refund Policy

Subscription fees are generally non-refundable once charged, except where a refund is required by applicable law or where an erroneous or duplicate charge, incorrect plan provisioning, payment/provider error, material service failure, or other exceptional circumstance warrants a refund or service credit. Refund requests are reviewed case-by-case where applicable.

Wrong-plan purchases may be reviewed case-by-case. Consumed credits may be considered when evaluating discretionary refunds, subject to applicable law.

This is a business policy and does not waive rights that cannot lawfully be excluded.

21. Taxes and Prices

Prices are displayed in Indian Rupees. At launch, Mehta Industries is not GST registered and no separate GST amount is displayed or collected on the listed VibeCheck subscription prices. The tax position will be re-evaluated upon GST registration or when a legal or tax trigger requiring collection arises. Any mandatory taxes or charges will be disclosed as required by applicable law.

22. Payments and Third-Party Providers

Payments are processed through Razorpay; authentication may use Google; AI processing uses Anthropic Claude; and production email may use Amazon SES. Third-party services are subject to their own applicable terms and privacy practices.

23. Service Availability

VibeCheck is provided on an as-available basis. Interruptions may result from maintenance, provider outages, network problems, security incidents, AI-provider failures, storage problems, billing-provider failures, or other causes.

24. Acceptable Use

You may not unlawfully process another person's data, upload malware, attack or disrupt the service, bypass authentication or access controls, access another user's contract, manipulate billing or credits, submit fraudulent payment information, impersonate another person, or use VibeCheck in violation of applicable law.

25. Account Suspension and Termination

Mehta Industries may suspend or terminate access where reasonably necessary to prevent fraud or abuse, protect users or infrastructure, enforce these Terms, comply with law, respond to security incidents, or address material non-payment. Immediate action may be required for security, fraud, legal, or safety reasons.

26. Account Closure and Data

You may request account deletion. Closing an account can cause loss of access to contracts, evaluations, reform records, proposal artifacts, and other service information. Deletion is subject to the Privacy Policy, applicable legal retention requirements, security records, accounting records, provider records, and backup lifecycle.

27. Intellectual Property

The VibeCheck software, interface, branding, documentation, and original platform content are owned by Mehta Industries or its licensors. Your use of VibeCheck does not transfer ownership of the platform to you.

28. Generated Output

Generated outputs may be machine-assisted, non-unique, incomplete, or incorrect. You are responsible for reviewing generated material before using it in negotiations, contracts, tax filings, regulatory submissions, or other consequential situations.

29. Third-Party Confidentiality and Lawful Use

You are responsible for ensuring that your use of VibeCheck is lawful and that you have permission to submit third-party data. VibeCheck does not verify your contractual confidentiality rights before processing an upload.

30. Changes to Features and Terms

We may modify, suspend, or discontinue features. We may update these Terms when the service, pricing, providers, or legal requirements change. Revised Terms will carry a new effective date and version.

31. Privacy

Your use of VibeCheck is also governed by the VibeCheck Privacy Policy, which describes data collection, AI processing, service providers, retention, privacy requests, and security practices.

32. Disclaimers

To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, VibeCheck disclaims warranties that results will be accurate, complete, current, error-free, legally sufficient, enforceable, compliant, fair, or appropriate to a particular transaction.

Nothing in these Terms excludes liability or statutory rights that cannot lawfully be excluded.

33. Limitation of Liability

Subject to applicable law, Mehta Industries limits aggregate liability arising from the Service to the fees paid by the affected user during the preceding 12 months, except to the extent a different limitation or carve-out is required by applicable law.

34. Indemnity

To the extent permitted by applicable law, you may be responsible for claims arising from unlawful uploads, unauthorized processing of third-party data, misuse of VibeCheck, fraud, or material breach of these Terms.

35. Governing Law

These Terms are governed by the laws of India, subject to mandatory law that cannot lawfully be contracted out of.

36. Disputes and Forum

Subject to applicable law, courts of competent jurisdiction in Baran, Rajasthan, India shall have exclusive jurisdiction over disputes arising out of or relating to these Terms or the Service, to the extent legally permissible.
